Fifty Years ago the erstwhile Indian Airlines had a dream to open an 'Air University' which will provide world class training to aviation personnel. That dream became a reality with the founding of Central Training Establishment popularly known as CTE, nestling on a sprawling 20 acres of lush green area close to the old Airport at Begumpet, Hyderabad.

It is an Institute to reckon with its inception in 1958 CTE has grown in stature and has developed into the epicentre of training in all aspects of Aviation.

With the concept of 'Air University' all the training centres have been brought under one roof. The existing infrastructure has the capability of training its own personnel as well as outside agencies.





On 1st November, 1995 CTE was declared as Independent profit centre. It has earned a lot of revenue, in terms of foreign exchange as well as by imparting training to airline personnel from abroad.

The Central Training Establishment is situated on the Perimeter of Old Hyderabad Airport and is about 8 Kms. From Secunderabad Railway Station and about 35 Kms from Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Shamshabad. Hyderabad, the fifth largest city in India, has a salubrious climate throughout the year (mean temperature 30° C). During summer months – April to June, the maximum temperature hovers around 35°-40°C. In winter, minimum temperature is about 12° C. Monsoon begins in June and lasts upto September. Evenings are generally pleasant, Rest of the year also the climate is generally pleasant.
